Excursion to GRSE Waterfall/Ile aux Cerfs on speed boat with nautical activities

The Public Officers' Welfare Council is organising an excursion to Ile aux Cerfs with sightseeing at GRSE Waterfall for public officers and their families on **Sunday 08 December 2019**.

2. The departure will be from Trou-d'Eau-Douce at Le Four-A-Chaux Jetty on speed boat. The programme of the day will be as follows:

Time	Programme of the day
0900hrs	Embarcation on speed boat from Trou-d'Eau-Douce at Le Four-A-Chaux Jetty and Visit of Grand River South East Waterfalls
1000 hrs	Arrival at Ile-aux-Cerfs - relax time and nautical activities;
1000 hrs to 1100 hrs	Snacks, soft drinks and water service on Ile aux Cerfs Island; Snacks: petit pain fouré aux fromages, samoussa fromage, paté de légumes, rouleau de légumes
1100 hrs to 1200 hrs	Relax time for participants Water sport activities (parasailing & tube riding)
1200 hrs to 1330 hrs	Lunch and soft drinks on Ile aux Cerfs Island Menu non - veg : pasta salad + grilled chicken + grilled fish + green salad + chicken sausage Menu veg : farata, rice, gros pois curry, giraumon, rougaille soya and paneer
1330 hrs to 1530 hrs	Relax time for participants Water sport activities (parasailing & tube riding)
1530 hrs to 1600 hrs	Embarcation on speed boat from Ile aux Cerfs to Trou-d'Eau-Douce- Le Four-A-Chaux Jetty

3. The cost of tickets is as follows:

- Note:**
1. child aged under 2 years is free of charge;
 2. child aged between 3 and 5 years - child rate is applicable;
 3. child aged 6 years and above - adult rate is applicable;
 4. child below 4 years is not allowed to participate in parasailing activity;
 5. child below 6 years is not allowed to participate in Tube riding Activity; and
 6. every child aged between 4 and 9 years must be accompanied by an adult for water sport activities

4. Departure from pick-up points will be as follows:

(e)	Pamplemousses (Parking SSR Botanical Garden)	0815

Please note that buses will leave their respective pick-up points at the time indicated above to reach Trou-d'Eau-Douce at Le Four-A-Chaux Jetty. Departure from the island in the afternoon is scheduled at 1530 hrs. Latecomers will have to make their own transport arrangements in both cases.

5. Participants are advised to wear comfortable walking shoes and to bring along sunglasses, cap/hat, insect repellent, swimwear and towel.

6. Interested public officers are requested to fill in the participation form (**Annex A**) and submit same together with the exact amount on the scheduled date of payment. The following documents should be submitted while effecting payment:

- (i) a photocopy of a recent payslip/top part of the payslip indicating the name, paysite code and National Identity Card number or any written evidence/document attesting that the applicant is a serving public officer;
- (ii) photocopy of National Identity Card for each adult; and
- (iii) photocopy of Birth Certificate for any participant under the age of 18 years

7. Payment will be received on a first come, first served basis as from **Thursday 26 September 2019** from 0930 to 1400 hours at the seat of the POWC, **6th Floor, ATOM House, 16, Royal Street, Port Louis.**

Applicants are kindly requested to effect payment preferably by card or cheque to the order of "Public Officers' Welfare Council".

8. Cancellation will be accepted only in exceptional cases (e.g. illness, death of close relative or any other valid reason) supported by documentary evidence. In case of cancellation an administrative fee of Rs. 200 per participant together with other cancellation charges claimed by stakeholders will be applicable.

9. The POWC reserves the right to cancel the activity/visit in case of bad weather or any other unforeseen circumstance. Participants will be refunded accordingly.
