Ministries/Departments/Staff Welfare Associations/Divisions willing to participate in the Domino Tournament are requested to fill in the attached participation form (**Annex B**) and submit same to the Welfare Events Organiser, Public Officers' Welfare Council, 12th Floor, SICOM Building 2, Corner Chevreau and Reverend Jean Lebrun Streets, Port Louis by 15 00 hours on Thursday, 14 May 2026 at latest.
8. Participants will have to submit with the participation form, a photocopy of a recent payslip or top part of the payslip, indicating the name, paysite code and National Identity Card number or any written document/evidence attesting that the participant is a serving Public Officer.
9. **The participation form should be endorsed by the Supervising Officer and should bear the seal of the participating Ministry/Department. In case of non-compliance, the participation form will not be considered by the POWC.**
10. Participants will be informed about the venue for preliminaries and finals accordingly. **Mobile number and e-mail address** of all participants are important so that they may easily be contacted in case need arises.
11. **All matches will start at 12:00 hours. Participating team who is not present by 12:15 hours; their opponent will automatically win the match by walkover and will be eliminated from the Tournament.**
12. The POWC reserves the right to cancel the Tournament in case of low participation or any unforeseen circumstances.
