Badminton Tournaments 2016

The Public Officers' Welfare Council is organising its annual Badminton Tournaments for public officers in September this year.

2. Two separate Tournaments will be organised as follows:
 - (a) Civil Service Men Badminton Tournament; and
 - (b) Civil Service Ladies Badminton Tournament.

The rules and regulations of the Tournaments are at Annex A.

3. The official matches will be played as from 1300 hours during weekdays. Participating teams should make their own arrangements for transport facilities and release of players/officials for training purposes and official matches from their respective Ministry/Department.
4. Ministries/Departments interested to participate in the above Tournaments are requested to fill in the enclosed participation form and submit same to the Organising Secretary, Public Officers' Welfare Council, 6th Floor, ATOM House, 16, Royal Street, Port Louis by **Friday 05 August 2016** at latest. **It is compulsory that the participation form should contain the seal of the participating Ministry/Department and duly certified by its Human Resource Section.**
5. Team Managers are requested to attend a meeting which will be followed by the drawing of lots on **Thursday 18 August 2016 at 1400 hours** in the Conference Room of the POWC, 6th Floor, ATOM House, Port Louis. During the meeting, Players' Licence Cards of participating teams should be submitted to the POWC for renewal and same should be collected before the Tournaments start.
6. Each participating team, after playing all matches, will be entitled to a grant of Rs 1 500, provided that its respective Staff Welfare Association possesses/holds a valid bank account.
