Volleyball Tournaments 2016

The Public Officers' Welfare Council is organising its annual Volleyball Tournaments for public officers in July 2016.

2. Three separate Tournaments will be organised as follows:

- (a) Civil Service Volleyball Tournament (Men);
- (b) Disciplined Forces Volleyball Tournament (Men); and
- (c) Civil Service/Disciplined Forces Volleyball Tournament (Ladies).

The rules and regulations of the Tournaments are at Annex A.

3. The official matches will be played as from 1300 hours during weekdays. Participating teams should make their own arrangements for transport facilities and release of players/officials for training purposes and official matches from their respective Ministry/Department.

4. Ministries/Departments interested to participate in the above Tournaments are requested to fill in the enclosed appropriate participation form (Annex B & C) and submit same to the Organising Secretary, Public Officers' Welfare Council, 6th Floor, ATOM House, 16, Royal Street, Port-Louis by **Friday 01 July 2016** at latest. **It is compulsory that the participation form should contain the seal of the participating Ministry/Department and duly certified by its Human Resource Section.**

5. Team Managers of participating Ministries/Departments in each Tournament will be convened to a meeting, which will be followed by the drawing of lots, on **Friday 08 July 2016 at 1400 hours** in the Conference Room of the POWC, 6th Floor, ATOM House, Port Louis. During the meeting, Players' Licence Cards of participating teams should be submitted to the POWC for renewal and collect same before the start of the Tournaments.

6. Each participating team, after playing all matches, will be entitled to a grant of Rs 2 500, provided that its respective Staff Welfare Association holds a valid bank account.
