LOGO COMPETITION-POWC SILVER JUBILEE

The Public Officers' Welfare Council (POWC), operating under the aegis of Ministry of Civil Service and Administrative Reforms, caters for the welfare of public officers and their families. Since its creation in 1992, the Council has been working actively for the benefit of public officers in various fields such as Sports and Keep-Fit, Recreational and Leisure, Literary and Cultural, Information, Education and Communication as well as the organization of an annual Civil Service Kermesse.

2. This year, the Council is celebrating its 25th Anniversary. In this context, the Council is organizing a Logo Competition based on the theme "POWC-Silver Jubilee". The participation is open to all public officers.

3. The selected logo will be used in official correspondences, banners, POWC website and emails highlighting the 25 years of existence of the Council.

Guidelines and Conditions for participation

- I. Format - Vector format and high definition jpeg.
 - II. Colour - Maximum four flat colours or quadrichromy (full colour).
 - III. The logo must also be submitted in colour A4 size along with a reduced black and white version of 3 cms x 3 cms.
 - IV. The maximum number of entries per individual shall be limited to three.
 - V. A brief on the logo explaining the various features and its significance must also be submitted.
 - VI. The designer of the selected logo may be requested to modify the logo at no extra cost.
 - VII. Each entry shall be an original work and free from any copyright.
 - VIII. (a) Each entry shall be signed by a pseudonym on the verso;
(b) the name, address, telephone number, pseudonym used together with a photocopy of a recent payslip or top part of payslip indicating the name, paysite code or any written evidence/document certifying that the participant is a serving public officer, shall be submitted in a separate sealed envelope and inserted into the main envelope; and
(c) name of the designer shall not be written on any envelope.
4. A cash prize of Rs 10 000 will be awarded to the best selected entry.
 5. The decision of the Jury Panel shall be final and binding.
 6. The Jury Panel reserves the right not to recommend any award following this competition.
 7. The selected logo shall become the property of the POWC and shall be used in various forms and formats.

8. Entries not retained may be returned to participants, upon request.
9. Interested public officers are requested to submit their logo proposal with all relevant documents in a sealed envelope with the mention "Logo Competition" to the Organising Secretary, Public Officers' Welfare Council, 6th Floor, Atom House, 16, Royal Street, Port Louis by Wednesday 19 April 2017, at latest.
10. It would be appreciated if this circular letter could be brought to the attention of all officers serving in your Ministry/Department.
